INTERfaces Newsletter



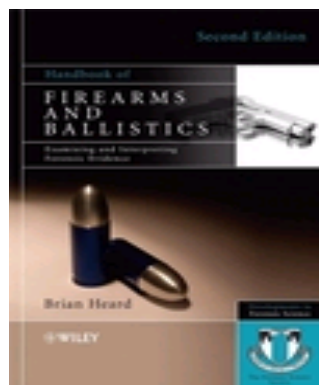
INTERfaces is the Forensic Science Society's quarterly newsletter. The aim of INTERfaces is to keep readers up to date with FSSoc developments.
